Transfer of Credit

- ▶ Transfer credit may be awarded for courses successfully completed with an earned grade of C or better
- ▶ Students may transfer a maximum of 136 lower division quarter credit hours
 - Lower division courses taken that are similar in content to Mid-America College of Funeral Service required courses, as determined by the appropriate Mid-America College of Funeral Service office, do not need to be retaken
- ▶ Students may transfer a maximum of 12 upper division elective quarter credit hours

Bachelor Degree Requirements

- ▶ The following are requirements for the Bachelor of Science in Funeral Service Management degree
 - Acceptance into the Bachelor of Science in Funeral Service Management program
 - Have successfully completed and graduated with an Associate's degree in Funeral Service from an ABFSE accredited institution
 - Complete a minimum of 180 quarter credit hours or 120 semester credit hours towards graduation
 - Complete the requirements of the Bachelor of Science in Funeral Service Management program core courses
 - Upper division core courses are required (44 quarter credit hours)
 - A minimum of 45 general education and/or liberal art quarter hour credits are required
