

Entrance Assessment Requirements

Change to Entrance Assessment Requirement

Effective Immediately

Mid-America College of Funeral Service hereby rescinds the former requirement listed as item #8 under “Application and Acceptance” (the required entrance assessment). Applicants will no longer be required to pass a standardized entrance exam (e.g. Wonderlic, SAT, ACT) for admission. Revised Application & Acceptance Requirements.

Accordingly, the revised admissions requirements are as follows:

Revised Application and Acceptance Requirements

To be considered for admission, an applicant must submit the following:

1. A completed application for the desired program
2. The \$50.00 non-refundable application fee
3. Enrollment documents completed via DocuSign for the chosen program
4. A high school transcript certifying graduation or a GED certificate (or equivalent), sent directly from the certifier
5. Compliance with Indiana law on school attendance (as applicable)
6. Official transcripts from previously attended institutions (if any)
7. A recent photograph for identification purposes (e.g. driver’s license or state ID preferred)

Item #8 (entrance assessment) is no longer required and should be considered removed from the catalog and any admissions documentation.

Clarification Note

While the College continues to adhere to applicable educational and licensing requirements as determined by each state’s funeral service licensing board, the admissions process itself no longer imposes a standardized entrance exam. The institution reserves the right, where permitted by law and policy, to deny admission in cases where an applicant is not in the best interest of the College, its students, or the funeral service profession.
