Application and Acceptance Process

The application for matriculation should be completed online at the link above. In addition, the following items are required for admission and acceptance to the College:

1. A completed application for the desired program;
2. A \$50.00 non-refundable application fee;
3. The applicant must be at least 18 years of age at the time of program start;
 - a. Indiana Law requires a student to attend school until the individual graduates or turns 18 unless they are between age 16 and 18 and their parents and the school principal consent in writing to their withdrawal at an exit interview (Indiana Code, Sec. 20-8. 1-3-17);
4. Completion of all required enrollment documents via DocuSign for the selected program;
5. A high school transcript certifying graduation, or a GED certificate with scores, sent directly to the College from the issuing institution, or an approved equivalent;
6. Official transcripts from all previously attended postsecondary institutions, sent directly to the College from the issuing institutions;
7. A recent photograph for identification purposes only:
 - a. A driver's license or state-issued identification card is preferred;
8. Documentation of bacterial meningitis immunization or an approved exemption, in accordance with state requirements.

The College reserves the right to refuse admission to any applicant when such action is deemed to be in the best interest of the College, its faculty, staff, students, or the funeral service profession.

Once the application and all required admissions documentation have been submitted to the Admissions Office, the application will be reviewed and an admissions decision will be made. Applicants may be contacted via email if additional documentation is required prior to a final decision.

At this time, Mid-America College of Funeral Service is not SEVIS-approved by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security and is unable to enroll international students.
